The Council of the College approved and released a Statement on Equity, Diversity, Inclusion and Belonging (EDIB) in December 2022, acknowledging the historic and ongoing harm caused by racism and discrimination, committing the Council to examining racism and discrimination in the College's regulatory proceedings and policies, and taking steps to rectify and/or eliminate them through a variety of means. An EDIB Council Governance policy and updates to the College's Workplace Harassment Executive Limitations policy were also approved, and an EDIB statement was added to the Career Opportunities page of the College's website to highlight the College's commitment to fostering a diverse and inclusive work environment.

In recognition that some police agencies/jurisdictions no longer issue hardcopy criminal record checks, the College began accepting electronic reports (an amendment to the Registration Policy). Hardcopy reports are still required where the agency/jurisdiction still issues these. To reduce timelines and allow for ease of submission, the quarantor requirement for public register photo submissions was also removed (an additional amendment to the Registration Policy), thereby allowing softcopy submissions to be made by applicants and Registrants (see comments in response to question 13). Additionally, an Alternative Documentation policy was created for the handling of instances where an applicant or PLAR applicant is unable to produce a required document (including proof of identity, reflected in amendments to the College's Proof of Identity policy) due to exceptional circumstances.
