

## **Retaking Entry-to-Practise Exams**

A candidate who fails an examination on the first attempt can apply to retake it a second time. After a second failure, the candidate must complete remediation as directed by a panel of the Registration Committee before a third and final attempt. An exam candidate who fails on the third attempt is not eligible to continue in the examination process without first completing an additional program of study in naturopathic medicine.

To retake any of the College's entry-to-practise exams, the following actions are required:

- Submit a new copy of your valid photo identification.
- Ensure the residential address and contact information listed on your College profile is still correct or has been appropriately updated.
- Complete the Online Examination Registration process, including payment of the applicable fee(s).
- Submit an examination accommodation request with supporting documentation (if required) by the examination's accommodation request deadline (as noted on the examination's Fees and Schedule page).

Note: if seeking to register for a third attempt of an examination, the College must first be in receipt of proof of completion of any panel mandated remediation before registration is permitted.
