ON READING the Notice of Hearing, the Agreed Statement of Facts and the Joint Submission as to Penalty and Costs, and on hearing the submissions of counsel for the College of Naturopaths of Ontario ("College") and Anna Blaszczyk (the "Registrant"):

A. THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE FINDS that the Registrant committed acts of professional misconduct pursuant to section 51(1)(c) of the *Health Professions Procedural Code*, being Schedule 2 to the *Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991* (the "Code") as set out the following paragraphs of section 1 of Ontario Regulation 17/14 made under the *Naturopathy Act, 2007*: **Paragraph 27** (Permitting the advertising of the member or his or her practice in a manner that is false or misleading or that includes

statements that are not factual and verifiable); Paragraph 30 (Inappropriately using a term, title or designation in respect of the member's practice); Paragraph 36 (Contravening, by act or omission, a provision of the Act, the Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991 or the regulations under either of those Acts, including but not limited to section 4 and section 7 of the Quality Assurance Regulation); Paragraph 39 (Practising the profession while the member's certificate of registration has been suspended); Paragraph 40 (Directly or indirectly benefiting from the practice of the profession while the member's certificate of registration is suspended unless full disclosure is made by the member to the College of the nature of the benefit to be obtained and prior approval is obtained from the Executive Committee); Paragraph 46 (Engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional); and Paragraph 47 (Engaging in conduct that would reasonably be regarded by members as conduct unbecoming a member of the profession).

B. THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE MAKES AN ORDER:

1. Requiring the Registrant to appear before the panel to be reprimanded immediately following the hearing of this matter.
