Registration Renewal in full swing!

Registration Renewal has officially launched. **March 31, 2019** is the deadline for all Members to complete their registration renewal. **Please check your emails for your link to renew**.

Renewal is a two-step process that includes completing the Information Return form and paying your annual registration fee. You must do both or your renewal will be incomplete and you could incur an administrative fee as a result.

Mandatory Patient Privacy Breach reports due March 1

Members are legally required to report privacy breaches of a patient's personal health information to the <u>Information and Privacy Commissioner of Ontario (IPC)</u> each year.

Privacy breaches may include information about a patient that was stolen, lost, used without authority and/or disclosed without authority. Any regulated health professional who had at least one privacy breach of a patient's personal health information during the 2018 reporting year—from January to December, are required by law to complete the <u>online reporting</u> <u>questionnaire</u> by **Friday, March 1, 2019**.

Do not submit a statistical report if you did not have any patient health information privacy breaches in 2018. This <u>letter</u> from the IPC contains more information, including what NDs must report.

Searching for volunteers!

We are seeking NDs to sit on statutory and non-statutory College Committees and the newly-created Investment Advisory Committee, and to serve as Examiners for 2019.

Are we permitted to release laboratory results to a patient at their request without first reviewing them at their visit?

Yes. Laboratory results are part of the patient record, therefore a patient can request a copy without first having a visit with the Member. The Member may choose to advise the patient that they would like to review the results in person, however they cannot withhold the results from the patient.
