Is your CPR certification current?

General class Members must have valid Healthcare Provider Level CPR at all times. One (1) year and two (2) year CPR certifications must be renewed on or before their expiry date. When do I have to submit my next continuing education (CE) logs?

Members in Group II are required to <u>submit their CE and Professional Development logs</u> by September 30, 2019. <u>Find your group</u>. The Resources section of our website includes full details, including the <u>CE Handbook</u>, log forms, and more. (Note that you will need to know your initial registration date with the BDDTN or College, which you can easily check in the online <u>Public Register of NDs</u>.)
