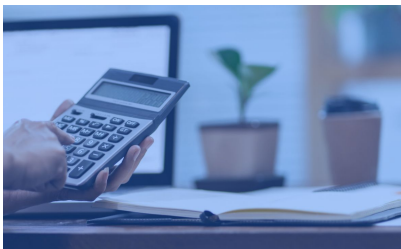


## ***Get Ahead with Your 2024 Self-Assessments***

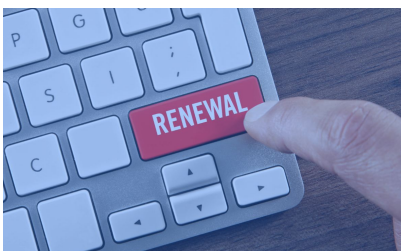


## ***Notice of Fees Changes***

The College [by-laws \(Sections 18.04 and 25.01.1\)](#) state that registration fees and fees relating to professional corporations are adjusted annually by an amount equivalent to the change in the provincial Consumer Price Index (CPI). They also state that Registrants must be notified about the change in fees resulting from this automatic increase.

This year, [Statistics Canada](#) released numbers indicating a 3.3% increase in the All Items – Ontario CPI. As a result, the effected fees will increase by 3.3%.

## ***Previewing the 2024 Registration Renewal Season***

The 2024 renewal period begins February 14, 2024. Preparing early and submitting your return on time will help ensure an easy and seamless renewal. Here are some things you can do in advance to get ready.

Please note that this year's deadline for renewal, March 31, 2024, is a Sunday.

The deadline falls in between the College's Easter closure, and College staff will not be available after 5:00 p.m. ET on March 28 until the office reopens on April 2, 2024. You're encouraged to renew early as the data you input on your Information Return form may require further review before it can be approved.

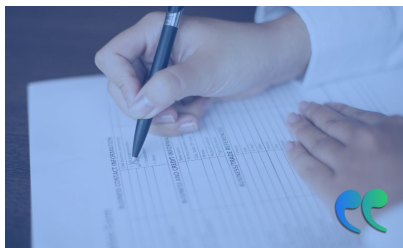
## ***Open Consultation: Proposed Changes to the Registration Policy – Currency***

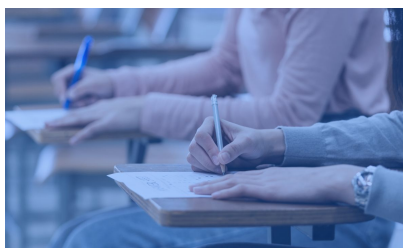


### ***Open Consultation: Data Collection***
