Formal Consultation - Oral Micronized Progesterone (Removal of Limitation)

Following the previous consultation and the review of stakeholder feedback, the College has updated its proposed amendment to Table 3, Drugs that may be Prescribed, of the General Regulation to permit naturopaths to prescribe Oral Micronized Progesterone without limitations. Supporting documentation is provided to inform you of this consultation. Registrants, partners and interested stakeholders are invited to review the proposal and submit their feedback **by March 4, 2026**.

Notice of Registration and Professional Corporation Fees Change

As part of the annual review, the College is advising registrants of updates to registration and Professional Corporation fees for the 2026-27 registration year. In keeping with the College's by-laws, fees have been adjusted based on the Ontario Consumer Price Index for All-Items November 2025, resulting in a 1.9% increase, alongside Council-approved changes. The renewal period starts **on February 13, 2026**.

Therapeutic Prescribing Standard (TPS) Data Collection & Reporting

As we enter the new year, registrants are reminded of the Therapeutic Prescribing Standard (TPS) Data collection requirement, which supports oversight of drugs and substances prescribed, dispensed, compounded, sold, or administered. Registrants who have met the Standard of Practice for Prescribing are encouraged to enroll in the TPS Support system for 2026 and review reporting requirements.

The College will be corresponding with each registrant who has met the Standard of Practice on Therapeutic Prescribing shortly to advise on when and how to submit your data from 2025.
